



**A RESOLUTION
BY COUNCILMEMBER H. LAMAR WILLIS**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE
TO IDENTIFY COMPANIES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND
FACILITATION OF A SECURITY AUDIT OF ALL CITY PROPERTIES.**

WHEREAS, security concerns have arisen as a result of recent events in municipalities throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, efforts to ensure that all City properties are secured must be undertaken; and,

WHEREAS, individuals representing the City of Atlanta that either serve as employees, are appointed or elected should be insured a safe work environment; and,

WHEREAS, in the past the City has secured pro-bono services to provide specialized expertise in certain areas; and,

WHEREAS, expertise in security continues to evolve as it relates to public properties and current resources relating to security are limited.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor be authorized to enter into an agreement for pro bono services with a security firms qualified to provide a full security audit of all properties owned by the City of Atlanta.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to accept the donation of said security audit services from a firm designated by the Mayor's office on behalf of and for the benefit of the City of Atlanta, and that the City shall incur no liability for the acceptance of such pro bono services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney shall prepare an appropriate contractual agreement for execution by the Mayor, to be approved by the City Attorney as to form. However, said agreement shall not become binding on the City, and the City shall not incur any liability there under, until the agreement has been signed by the Mayor and attested to by the Municipal Clerk.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
